Since 2011, a total of 111 sites of prehistoric pile dwellings in six countries surrounding the Alps have been listed as UNESCO World Heritage Sites. A unique historical archive has been preserved in the lakes. Pile fields and everyday objects tell the story of the lives of the early inhabitants of our region.

The Unteruhldingen Museum brings this underwater cultural heritage to life again. 23 reconstructed houses with interior furnishings tell of life in the Stone and Bronze Ages many thousands of years ago. The New Museum transports you to the underwater world and shows you the unique world of pile dwellings.

WELCOME TO THE PILE DWELLINGS

Follow the **traces of the pile dwellers** inside the New Museum.

First, discover the valuable original finds from the bottom of Lake Constance in the display cases on hunting, food, clothing, and household management. Enjoy the unique new building with its light sculpture, whose wooden construction resembles an upside-down log boat. Dive into the underwater world: At the **ARCHAEORAMA**, join the diving archaeologists on their research expedition – without getting wet. As you move along the walkways, admire the **authentically furnished pile dwellings** of the Bronze Age and the Stone Age. The tools and jewelry, the clothing, and the weapons that you just saw in their original state of preservation in the display cases are displayed here true to the original and are ready to be touched. Lifelike displays, special exhibitions, and **a house with all the important questions and answers** line your journey. Unique programs are held regularly in the **Stone Age Course** and the **Green Classroom**.

At the end of your tour, you can relive all your impressions of pile dwellings here and around the world in the **gallery** of the new building. The threats to the World Heritage sites today and the remaining **mysteries of the pile dwellers** for research will also be highlighted there.
